2018-2019 SCHOLARSHIP/FINANCIAL AID APPLICATION – Every year, St. Aloysius School awards over fifty need-based scholarships. Need is always the prime determinant for selection. Other criteria considered in selection are good character, satisfactory achievement, and activities. Four scholarships are designated for minority students. Scholarships awards range in value from \$500 to full tuition. All submitted information remains confidential. A scholarship selection committee meets to determine recipients. *To be considered, a student must be an enrolled kindergartner through eighth grader for the year applying for assistance.*

The 2018-2019 scholarship/financial aid application is now available. Applications can be found under Important Links on the main page of school website and in the school office. Deadline for submission is Thursday, February 1st at 3:00 p.m. Notifications will be sent out to applicants in early March.


