

# 2018 CSAA DEVELOPMENTAL VOLLEYBALL GRADE 5 GIRLS

**PARENT MEETING.** A parent meeting will be held on **Sunday, January 28 at 6:30 pm in the old gym.**

**No otherwise eligible player may participate in a match until the required fee and forms are received by the athletic director.** Also, girls may not play volleyball and also participate in track.

The **first practice** will be held at the NEW Gym on **Sunday, February 18 from 1:00 to 2:20 pm.** The St. Aloysius team(s) will consist of girls in the fifth grade who were at least 10 on September 30th and who did not become 12 before September 1, 2017. All eligible girls who seek to play will be assigned to a team.

**SAS ELIGIBILITY** - The school administration may remove any student from eligibility should a serious incident occur during the school day or at a sports or school related activity. Eligibility is based on report cards and disciplinary matters in each nine week period and is reevaluated at the end of the next nine-week period. (See the School Parent/Student Handbook for details.)

General - The season begins March 11th and concludes by May 1. Practices are generally held on Saturday and Sunday afternoons based on coach and gym availability. League games are played on weekday evenings (5:45, 6:30, or 7:30 pm) and Saturday mornings. Matches are scheduled at the gyms of participating schools and officials are provided by the CSAA. Each match will consist of three games, regardless of outcome and each player must play at least one full game of the match. Standings are not kept nor championships awarded.

Uniform. Each player will be issued a match jersey. The jersey, as well as black volleyball shorts and white socks, are to be worn at matches. The jersey must be returned after the season. [See **Uniform Contract, Conflicts, and Shirt Order Form.**]

Equipment. Each player must provide her own black volleyball shorts and shoes and wear plain white socks during matches.

Fee. The fee is **\$110 payable to "St. Aloysius Athletic Department"** The fee includes your daughter's CSAA registration.

**PLAYER PARTICIPATION.** Team members will receive adequate playing time. However, match participation may be based on attendance and participation at practice, attendance at matches, conduct, and attitude. Each player present and available to play must play at least one game without substitution during one of the three games in the match. A third game will be played regardless of outcome of the first two games. A waiver is permitted for injury, disqualified player, and disciplinary action.

**REQUIRED FORMS** - Each student must, prior to such participation in a match, provide (1) completed uniform contract, conflicts, and shirt order form, (2) completed sports participation form, (3) completed sports contract form, and (4) completed medical history evaluation/physical examination form which verifies that the student is physically able to participate (forms available on the school's website under "Athletics").

**NOTE: Forms (2), (3) and (4) do not need to be submitted again if already turned in for the student in this school year for basketball, cross country, or swimming.**

**PARENTAL PARTICIPATION.** Parent participation is a necessary part of a successful sports program. Parents are responsible for getting their child to practices and contests on time and with the necessary equipment and are to pick up their child after practice or a contest on time.

Parent assistance is also needed in the collection of admission charges and the manning of the concession area at home matches and at our tournament. After team rosters are determined and league schedules received, a work schedule will be prepared and sent to the parents of team members with specific assignments for home matches on a rotating basis. These assignments will be made in a manner that the parent will be free to watch his or her child's match.

**NOTE: Jewelry may not be worn during matches and warm-ups. Earrings of any type are not permitted. Tape over earrings will not be permitted. Consider this before allowing your child to have her ears pierced during the volleyball season.**
