HANDBOOK UPDATE: The policy on school-issued student email accounts for 5th - 8th grade students has been added to the handbook on page 31. Parents of students in 5th-8th received the use policy agreement last week. The policy is below:

Students in 5th – 8th grade will be issued a school email. This account is not the same as a personal email account. The school account is a professional email account. Students should treat their school accounts the same way they should treat, in the future, an account assigned by an employer, or by a college/university. Students are expected to still use their personal email account for personal communication with family and friends, and use their school email account for school purposes. The school email account is monitored. Both students and parents will be required to sign a school email use policy agreement.
