

## 2017 Summer Math Program – Summer Solutions

Participation in summer math is **optional** for all students, but we strongly encourage participation. Parents can order the Summer Solutions Common Core Mathematics books at any time, and the book will be mailed to your home (shipping charges apply).

Approaching these grade-appropriate lessons consistently throughout the summer assures the greatest progress and retention. If you choose not to use this program, we encourage you to practice math skills in some way over the summer.
